Sullivan County is located on the western border of the state, south of center, bordering Vermont to the west with a 36-mile stretch of the Connecticut River. Sullivan County came into existence in 1827, made up of communities taken from Cheshire County. The name was in honor of General John Sullivan, a Revolutionary War hero, and author of New Hampshire's motto, "Live Free or Die." General Sullivan served as a member of the Continental Congress, Adjutant General to George Washington, and Major General of the Northern Army. He was elected "President" of New Hampshire in 1786, and the town of Sullivan in Cheshire County was named for him in 1787.

Sullivan County contains 537.8 square miles of land area and 14.3 square miles of inland water area. As of the 2020 Census, the population density was 80.1 persons per square mile. Sullivan County includes one city, Claremont, and 14 towns. The county seat is Newport..
